Training on prevention of child sexual Abuse

Introduction

Teachers have an important role in preventing child sexual abuse by providing safe learning environments, recognizing warning signs and assisting students who may be at risk. Schools are more safe spaces where children should feel protected, respected and empowered. Child sexual abuse is a serious concern and teachers must be prepared to prevent, recognize and respond to it effectively.

This training is intended to help school teachers understand the dynamics of child sexual abuse, such as common warning signs, grooming habits, and risk factors. Teachers will also learn about best practices for creating a safe classroom climate, setting appropriate boundaries, and reacting to disclosures with respect and care. This training would also address school policies, legal requirements, and reporting procedures, so that instructors can take appropriate action. Teachers may assist develop a culture of safety and trust by educating students, remaining vigilant, and committing to their well-being.

Brief note about the programme

According to the SCERT Director proceedings, "Prevention of Child Sexual Abuse and Awareness Week" was held in all types of schools in Tamilnadu from November 25 to November 29. The event was organized under the supervision of the Headmaster and followed proper protocols to benefit the students. Awareness posters were displayed in schools. They were also given students helpline numbers, such as Students sexual abuse Helpline 1098 and 14417, for emergency assistance. Relevant information about this program was also given to the students in the schools.

SCERT conducted a two-day state-level training from 16.12.2024 to 17.12.2024, at Pillar Hall in Madurai for prevention of child sexual abuse. one DIET faculty, BRTE and one P.G teacher were participated from each district as resource persons in the training. Following that, training was provided at the district level. The resource persons are BRTE, PG, and BT teachers. Those who attended the district-level training would act as resource persons for the block-level training. This training held on one day.

Planning meeting was conducted by DIET principal in DIET Dharmapuri. With the officials of District Child Protection officer, Child Welfare Committee, Police Department

and state RPs of Dharmapuri District. At district level one day training programme was organized at DIET. District level training was held on 21.01.2025.

The training was started with the Tamil thai valthu. Welcome address was given by Dr N. Indira, Lecturer, DIET. Mr. M. Mayilsamy, Vice-Principal, greeted the chief guest. Dr P. Govinda Prakash, Principal DIET addressed the gathering & explained about the roles and responsibilities of the teachers. Then he highlighted the importance of the training to the block level resource persons. Followed by technical sessions delivered by experts. Participants were educated on recognizing signs of abuse, understanding the psychological and legal implications, and learning preventive strategies that can be implemented in schools.

After that, resource persons continue the sessions. This effort aimed to create a safer and more supportive environment for children, with teachers playing an active role in ensuring their well-being.

Session wise report

Session 1

In the first session, Dr Indira, Lecturer, DIET has delivered the content about the prevention of child sexual abuse and overview of the module. Then she elaborated the Definition of child abuse: Physical, emotional, sexual abuse, and neglect, Signs and symptoms of child abuse, different types of sexual abuses that takes place for children, Role of teachers in preventing abuses, how to handle the children who have undergone sexual abuses, PAANT rule, students safety committee, measures to be taken once we come to know that a child has been sexually abused. She also explained three videos related to AVAL.

On this continuation our chief guest Mrs. Vijaya, Sub Inspector of Police, Palacode. She shared her experience about POCSO Act. She explained how sexual harassment can be prevented and how to create awareness among school children. She started case study report in a wonderful way.

Session 2

In the second session, continued with valuable speech by expert Mr. M. Selvam, District Child Welfare Officer, Dharmapuri. He explained in detail to the teachers about the rights of children, the POCSO Act - 2012, and the punishments given to people who sexually abuse children. Then he highlighted the salient features of POCSO Act, Roles and Responsibilities of DCPO, types of harassment, Children's rights, Child adoption law, Child adoption rules and CWC in implementation of POCSO Act.

Session 3

The third session started with the counselling to victims of sexual abuse by Mr. P. Tholkappian, BRTE, Karimangalam. He explained about common problems of school children and adolescence, factors affecting children, identified the symptoms of abuse, case studies, how to support the child and adolescent psychology, Emotional and psychological support for children who have experienced abuse, Role of teachers in providing initial emotional support, Referral to mental health professionals and support services, Building resilience and coping mechanisms in children.

Session 4

The last session was handled by Mrs. Kalpana. B.T Asst, Model School, Palacode. She explained the Role of Stakeholders and Rehabilitation of victims under POCSO Act, Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act-2012, Introduction to the Protection of

Those who participated in the district-level training acted as resource person in the block-level training. Block level training was held from 29.01.2025 to 31.01.2025. In block level training was given to one P.G teacher and one B.T teacher working in all government and government-aided, upper primary schools, high schools and higher secondary schools in the block.

Session wise Report

Session 1

Resource persons are briefed on the significance of the Act and the types of child abuse. They also described real-life abuse instances that occurred in our community. Participants took a pre-test using Google Forms. The following section offered an overview of child sexual abuse prevention and the relevant module. Participants watched three videos from the AVAL program. Resource Persons then spoke into detail about the POCSO Act 2012 , specifically sections 375, 376, and 377, as well as the important developments of the June 19, 2012, Gazette notification and the Lok Sabha (May 20) and Rajya Sabha (May 22) bill announcements. The various types of sexual offenses and their accompanying sanctions were further described, with complex legal concerns presented in a straightforward and understandable manner.

Session 2

After the tea break,the Resource Person, explained the salient features of the POCSO Act. They provided a detailed account of the roles and responsibilities of various organizations, including: CWC (Child Welfare Committee), CCC (Central Complaint Centre),Rights of the Victim, Roles of the Police and Special Agencies, Punishments under POCSO, Challenges and Limitations, Case Studies and Landmark Judgments. They emphasized the crucial roles of Headmasters, Teachers, and Parents in child protection.

Session 3

After the lunch break, conducted a session on Counselling for Victims of Sexual Abuse. They shared valuable insights from a psychologist's perspective and explained both physical and mental abuse. They discussed the importance of counselling for victims and emphasized the need for spending quality time with children, students safety committee and actively listening to their concerns.

Session 4

After the tea break, from DCPU explained the roles and responsibilities of the DCPO (District Child Protection Officer). They shared personal experiences related to child sexual abuse and discussed the prevention of child marriage, PAANT rule, the implementation of the Child Protection Officer (CPO) system, and the Adoption Centre in Dharmapuri District. They also introduced the CARA website and SARA website.
